

Co-Educator Add

Add a Co-Educator



1. Select "Classes & Students" in the left hand navigation.
2. Select the class settings gear to the far right of the class you would like.
3. Go to the "Co-Educator" tab in the modal window and enter the information.
4. Click on the highlighted "Send Co-Educator Invitation" box.
5. An invitation email will be sent to the educator letting them know that you have invited them to be a co-educator of your class.
6. Click on Save Settings.

Note: The co-educator must accept your invitation before they are able to view your class and the specific grade level educator resources.



- Refresh in KWOT (Green Circular Arrow)
- Use Firefox
- Go to the next stop sign and then quit browser
- Caps lock
- Hold down opposite side J/F in Target Practice

SeeSaw Examples

SeeSaw "Tipping" Points

- Student portfolio tools
- "Explanation" tool
- Insight into kid thinking
- All kids explain their thinking/answer at once
- Examples: math, fluency, writing, social studies and science
- Easy to setup and use - iPad based, uses camera, microphone, drawing, "keyboard"
- QR code gets student to the right class
